

 4. **Public Hearing on proposed FY24 City Budget. Pursuant to the Tex. Local Government Code, Chapter 102, the City Council will hold a Public Hearing regarding the proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024.**
This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$77,539.93 (5.61%) and of that amount \$16,343.39 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year.
 5. **Discussion and/or possible action on Ordinance 392, Approving and Adopting FY24 City Budget.**
 - a. **Discussion and ratification of tax rate for public hearing on September 26, 2023.**
Approval of this budget would require a min tax rate of 0.128402, which will be voted on September 26.
