PARKS-

There are (5) parks in Sunrise Beach. All Boat launches require a boat launch pass.

- **GRANITE SHOALS (Square Dock)** - This park is located on Park Lane in north Sunrise Beach. It has a boat launch, swimming dock, restroom and picnic facilities.
- **LAKESHORE PARK** - This park is located at the end of East Lakeshore Drive. It has a boat launch, restroom and picnic facilities.
- **TIMBERCOVE PARK** - This park is located off 2233. It has a children's playground, horseshoe pits, restroom and picnic facilities and a Pickleball/Basketball Court.
- **SANDY PARK** - This park is located on Sandy Mountain Drive on Sandy Creek. It has a swimming beach, restroom and picnic facilities.
- **McNair PARK** - This park is located on Park Road off Inspiration Drive. This is the main park in Sunrise Beach. It has a large, covered pavilion, boat launch, swimming, restroom and extensive picnic facilities. You may rent the pavilion for private parties by contacting City Hall or by completing the online application.

Boat Launch Fees are assessed at parks with boat launches. Residents of SRB can apply for boat launch passes through the website at WWW.SUNRISEBEACHTX.GOV.
